

Dr. P.V. Ramamurti is Professor Emeritus and the founder Director (Honorary) of the Centre for Research on Ageing, Dept. of Psychology, S.V. University. He served as the coordinator of the UGC, DSA Programme, as Dean of the School of Social and Behavioural Sciences, an UGC Emeritus fellow and former President of Association of Gerontology (India). He was a Fulbright Fellow (1983), visiting scholar at the Max Planck Institute Berlin, and at the Institute of Ageing Liverpool UK (1989), and an invitee to the Sandoz Lectures, Basle, (1992).

He is Associated as consultant with several International organizations such as the United Nations (Agenda for Ageing Research), UNFPA, Guest Faculty at the UN International Institute of Ageing, Malta (1998). He is recipient of Life Time Achievement Award of AGI, Swamy Pranavananda Award in Psychology (Research Contribution), Basu Medal (API), Distinguished Gerontologist (Age care).
